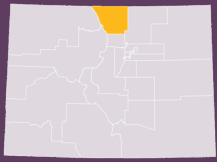

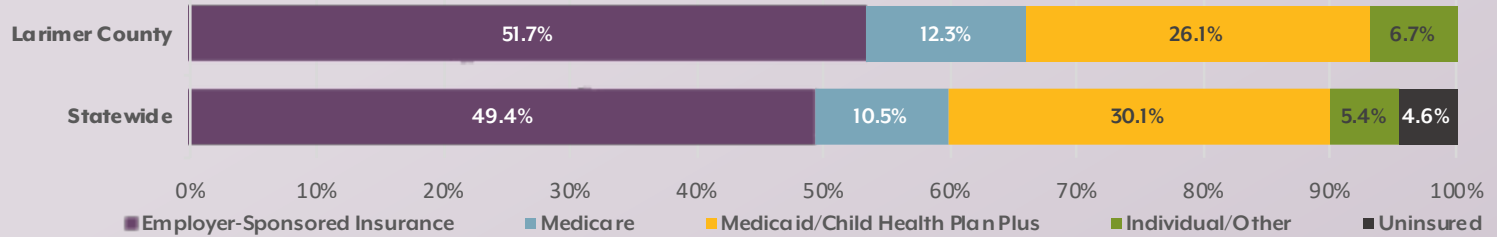

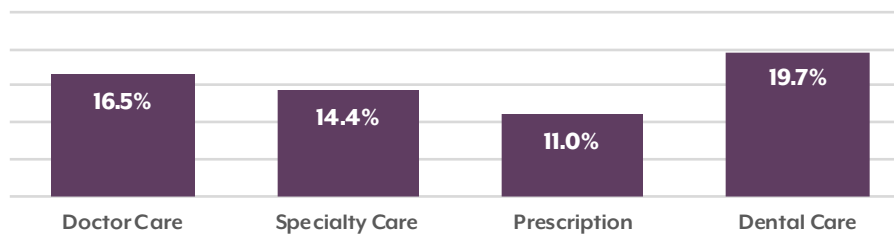
### Insurance Types

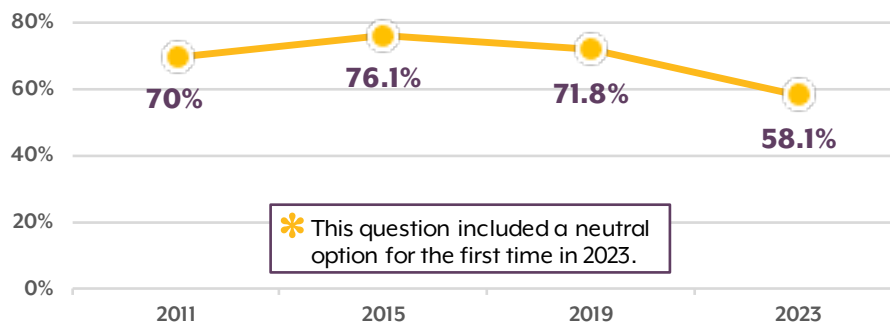
### Ability

### Opinions on the Health Care System

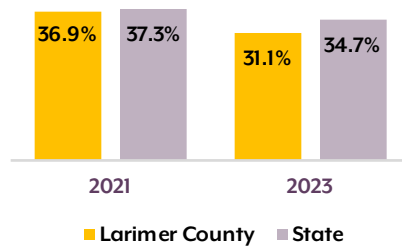
Agree that the current Colorado health care system meets their needs

### Broadband

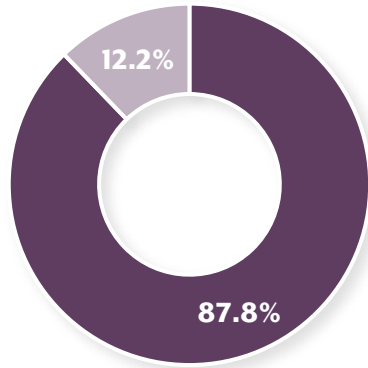
Households that do not have broadband internet service

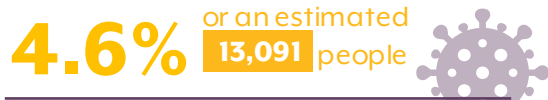

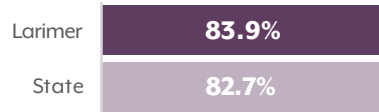

**Long COVID:** People age 16 and older with COVID symptoms lasting three months

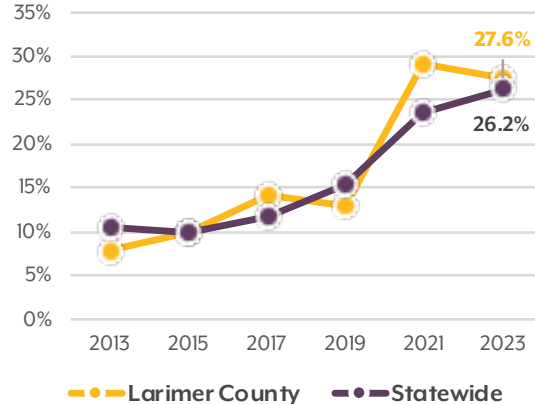

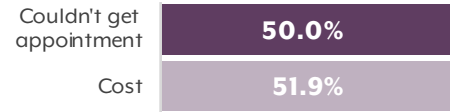
Eight or more days of poor mental health in the past month



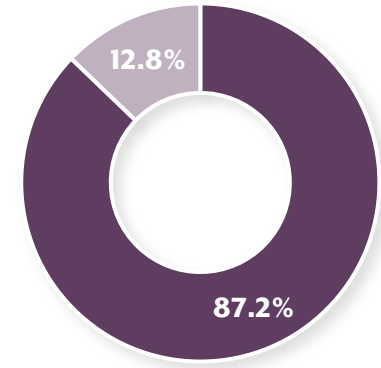
Needed mental health care but did not receive it



Reasons for not getting needed care

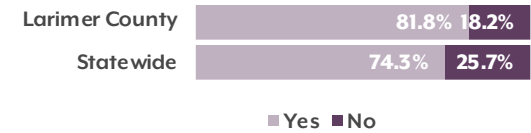

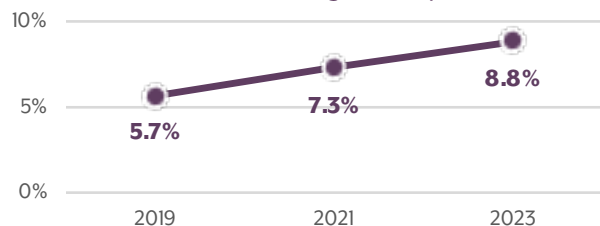
