About the Scholarship

CHI is offering a limited number of scholarships for people who meet at least one of the following criteria:

- · People who are early in their career or are current students
- · People representing rural organizations
- People representing grassroots organizations
- · People representing minority-led nonprofit organizations

Preference will be given to those applicants who:

- · Are focused on health equity or can demonstrate how they prioritize lenses of equity in their work; and/or
- · Are working to increase access to health for Coloradans who have been historically underserved or excluded

Each scholarship will cover the registration fee as well as conference meals (breakfast and lunch). Recipients from outside the Denver metro area may be approved for on-site hotel or travel accommodations if needed.

Scholarship recipients agree to share a short, written reflection or a "selfie-style" video after the conference about their Hot Issues in Health experience to help CHI better understand and communicate the value of the conference. These materials may be shared by the Colorado Health Institute via its newsletter and/or social media feeds. More details will be provided to selected scholarship recipients closer to the conference date.

Scholarship applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis beginning September 16, 2022.
